This organization was founded in 1947 by a Council of Churches that came together to be a unified voice for the church and was appropriately established as the Lancaster County Council of Churches.

Over the years, the organization grew and developed into a large social service agency providing

- Food, clothing, shelter and transportation for our neighbors in need.verified need for transportation to job.
- Bus tickets to work for those just starting a job, or in an emergency situation.
- Emergency relief aid to victims of natural disasters such as hurricanes.
- Emergency prescriptions assistance.
- Coordination assistance, support and promotion of Crop Walk.
- Partner Churches Referral Coordinator for utilities and rental assistance. LCCC assists congregations by screening clients applying for financial assistance. Clients are interviewed in a formatted process to determine eligibility. After the appointment, the referring church is contacted and able to make an informed decision.
- Share The Bounty fresh produce donated from farmers, gardeners, and growers is distributed to food banks, homeless shelters and soup kitchens.
